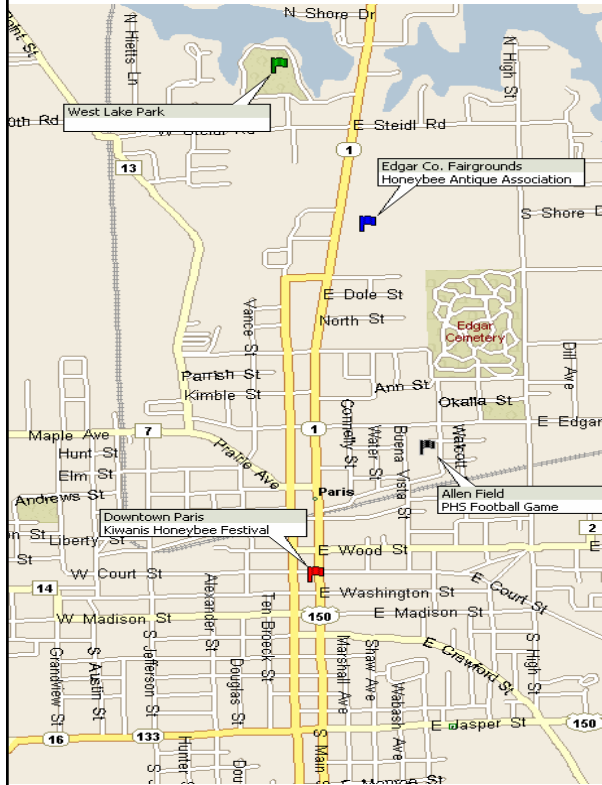

### Paris is located:

- ★ 15 miles North of I-70 on IL Highway Route 1
- ★ 13 miles South of Route 36 on IL Highway Route 1
- ★ 32 miles East of I-57 on IL Highway Route 133
- ★ 10 miles West of Indiana on US Highway 150

To get to courthouse square (at the corner of Main St. & Court St.) and the downtown area, take Route 1 (Main St.) into town and you can't miss it

The Fairgrounds is located on Route 1 (Main St.) approximately 1 mile north of the square.
