

2007 Honeybee Festival License Plate Order Form

This year marks the 27th Anniversary of the Honeybee Festival and we are again selling license plates. Due to some new rules put in place by the State of Illinois in the way it handles special event plates, there will be some changes in the way the Festival committee sells them.



The Secretary of State requires the following in order for special plates to be displayed on a vehicle:

The Special Event plates may be displayed on passenger vehicles, B-trucks, and recreational vehicles weighing 8,000 pounds or less for a period of 60 days ending on the last day of the event.. The vehicles must be currently registered in Illinois, and the owner must keep the regular license plates and registration ID card in the vehicle at all times. Souvenir plates may be ordered, but a valid registration must be submitted with the plate order.

Of special note this year is that your vehicle's registration must be current through the end of the festival, in other words, it must be valid through September 2007. What this means is that if your vehicle registration expires in July, August or September and you haven't already renewed it, you must renew before submitting your plate order. We realize that this could be a slight inconvenience, but the State of Illinois is requiring this change.

This year, the State has implemented one other change, but this should benefit everyone. They will be shipping the plates directly to you (to the same address as your vehicle registration). Be sure and get your order placed now so that you will ensure prompt delivery of your Honeybee License Plates.
