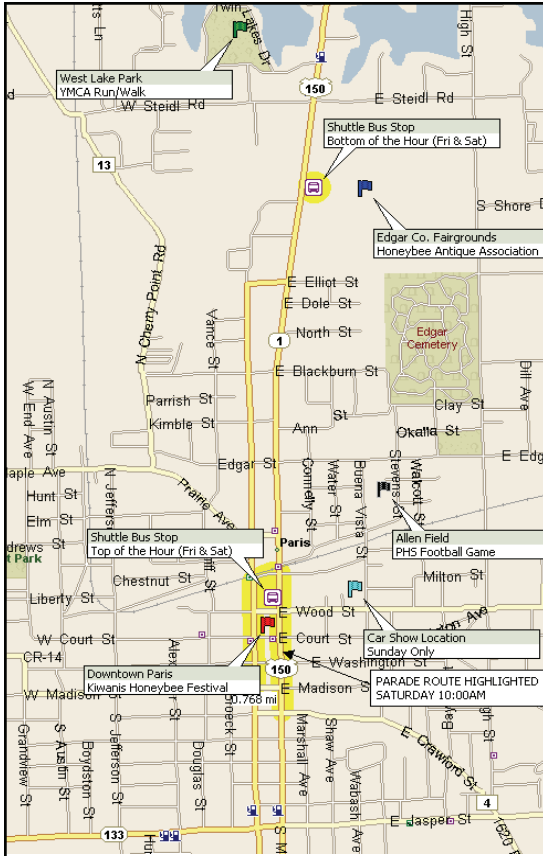

COME TO BEAUTIFUL PARIS, ILLINOIS FOR A WEEKEND FILLED WITH FUN, FOOD, AND FRIENDSHIP

Paris is located:

- ★ 15 miles North of I-70 on IL Hwy Rte 1
- ★ 13 miles South of Rte 36 on IL Hwy Rte 1
- ★ 32 miles East of I-57 on IL Hwy Rte 133
- ★ 10 miles West of Indiana on US Hwy 150

To get to courthouse square (at the corner of Main St. & Court St.) and the downtown area, take Route 1 (Main St.) into town and you can't miss it

The Fairgrounds is located on Route 1 (Main St.) approximately 1 mile north of the square.

A Shuttle bus operated by the East Central IL Mass Transit District will run between the fairgrounds and downtown on Sat. & Sun. Pickup will start downtown after the parade (11:30AM). It will pick up behind the Edgar County Bank at the top of every hour and near the Fairgrounds Main Entrance on Route 1 at the bottom of

the hour. Service ends at 7:00 on Sat and at 4:00 on Sunday.
