

2008 Honeybee Festival License Plate Order Form

This year marks the 28th Anniversary of the Honeybee Festival and the time has come once again to order your commemorative license plates. The new State rules that went into effect last year have not changed:



The Special Event plates may be displayed on passenger vehicles, B-trucks, and recreational vehicles weighing 8,000 pounds or less for a period of 60 days ending on the last day of the event.. The vehicles must be currently registered in Illinois, and the owner must keep the regular license plates and registration ID card in the vehicle at all times. Souvenir plates may be ordered, but a valid registration must be submitted with the plate order.

One thing we are going to have to do is cut back on the number of plates that we order. In the past we have ordered, paid for and received 200 plates. Since the state recycles any plates that aren't assigned, we can't afford to keep paying for plates that we don't end up selling. This year we are only going to order what we can sell. What this means for you is that you need to get your order & money in ASAP to ensure that you get a set of plates. More than likely we will order at least 100 plates, so if your previous number was in the range of 1-100, then we will do our best to get you the same plate. However, once we confirm with the state the number of plates we will be ordering, then the plates will be assigned on a first come basis. We apologize for this change for those of you who had numbers outside of the range that we order.

With the new rules implemented by the State last year, your vehicle's registration must be current through the end of the festival, in other words, it must be valid through September 2008. What this means is that if your vehicle registration expires in July, August or September and you haven't already renewed it, you must renew before your plates will be sent to you. We realize that this could be a slight inconvenience, but this is required by the State of Illinois. If you do need to renew your registration, you may go ahead and send in your plate order and payment now to ensure you will have a set of plates. Once you renew your registration so it is valid past the end of September you can send us a COPY of it.

The State will be shipping the plates directly to you (to the same address as your vehicle registration).

If you wish to order a plate this year and support the Kiwanis Honeybee Festival, please fill out the information below, remit **\$ 50.00 NOW** and a COPY of your vehicle registration NOW or by **July 25, 2008** to either of the addresses below. If you submit your registration after July 25, we will still forward it to the State, but the time you will be able to display them will be shortened.
