Honeybee License Plates Still Available

Paris, Ill.—The annual Honeybee Festival in Paris is just around the corner, and enthusiasts are already displaying their festival commemorative license plates. Any area resident may participate in this program that helps to promote the festival, which is scheduled for September 26-28.

Due to changes in Illinois requirements for special plates, vehicle registration must be current and must not expire before September 28. In other words, if a registration would expire between now and September 28, a driver must first renew the registration before ordering license plates. A copy of the vehicle registration form must accompany the order.

Plates will be sent to car owners through the mail. The license plates may be displayed on passenger vehicles as well as B-trucks and recreational vehicles weighing 8,000 pounds. The time period for display begins now and continues through the end of the festival. Both the license plate and registration ID cards must be kept in the vehicle displaying the plate at all times.
