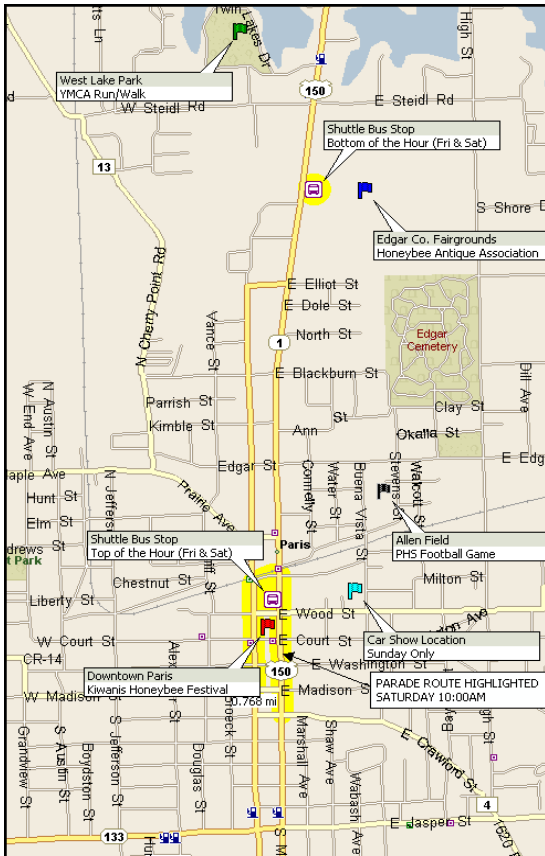

### Paris is located:

- ★ 15 miles North of I-70 on IL Hwy Rte 1
- ★ 13 miles South of Rte 36 on IL Hwy Rte 1
- ★ 32 miles East of I-57 on IL Hwy Rte 133
- ★ 10 miles West of Indiana on US Hwy 150

To get to courthouse square (at the corner of Main St. & Court St.) and the downtown area, take Route 1 (Main St.) into town and you can't miss it

The Fairgrounds is located on Route 1 (Main St.) approximately 1 mile north of the square.

**A Shuttle bus operated by the East Central IL Mass Transit District will run between the fairgrounds and downtown on Sat. & Sun. Pickup schedule as follows:**  
**SAT: 9:30AM-10:30AM & 12:30PM-5PM (No Service during Parade)**  
**SUN: 9:30AM-1PM. It will pick up behind the Edgar County Bank and near the Fairgrounds**

**Main Entrance on Route 1. Donations accepted and will be given to the United Way.**
